1. Improving internal governance structures and how we operate

- New Terms of Reference for SCSC SRB Shepherd adopted
- New Shepherd and Deputy Shepherd appointed
- New Principles and Procedures for the SRB Forum have been adopted
- New SRB Convenor to be appointed in the coming months
- Increased communication among SRB's, teleconference meetings and face to face workshop taking place between SCSC meetings
- The new governance procedures will improve SRB's ability to undertake collective initiatives and support APEC goals











2. Improved Effectiveness

Seeking to identify how SRB's can increase effectiveness and strengthen our ability to support APEC activities and priorities:

- Reviewing APEC Blueprint and activities to identify where SRB's can add value and focus resources
- This has taken longer than planned but aim is to present the results and an updated Strategic Plan and Programme of Work to SCSC1 in 2018
- Workshop is planned for Sydney in December 2017 to progress this work











3. Improved Communication

To promote the adoption of international standards and effective use of metrology and accreditation systems. Increase knowledge sharing in areas where we can best provide effective support to APEC economies:

- SRB's have participated in a range of workshops within the SRB forum group and undertaken joint initiatives in areas of mutual interest, i.e. APLAC and APMP work together on proficiency testing, APLMF and APMP on Metrology Enabling Developing Economies in Asia (MEDEA) project initiatives
- SRB's have worked to retain and grow their memberships
- Website improvements to facilitate information transfer:
 - APLMF / APMP currently developing a joint web portal to promote the benefits of metrology and share case studies and resources - Metrology Asia Pacific: www.metrologyasiapacific.com
 - www.publicsctorassurance.org website which showcases how accredited conformity assessment is used around the world by regulators to deliver positive benefits
