- Continuing to developing a Secretariat process manual
- Increased the frequency of the member newsletter and membership communications
- The MEDEA partnership continues to be a jewel in the crown for the development of skills through training. We are looking forward to continued support through MEDEA 2.
 - MEDEA has had significant impact on the Region's legal metrology capability
 - Since November 2015 APLMF/MEDEA have supported the training of 190 people across 21 economies.

- On-line learning is coming. An on-line learning prototype has been developed and progressing this initiative is a key focus for 2018
- Continued presence at APEC and associated fora to promote legal metrology and the increased capability within Asia Pacific region

- The APLMF Strategic Plan was reviewed and endorsed by members
 - Five year strategy 2017-2021 (reviewed every two years)
