BRIEF OVERVIEW OF FSFG

✓ Food Safety Focus Group (FSFG) was founded in 2015 under the APMP framework, aiming to enhance member economies' measurement capabilities in food safety area, thus to realize mutual recognition and to facilitate regional trade.

✓In 2017, two new members: NMIM (Malaysia) and CSIRNPL (India) joined us, making FSFG now consisted of 15 NMIs/DIs, including: GLHK (Hong Kong China), HSA (Singapore), KRISS (Korea), NIM (China), NIMT(Thailand), MSL-IRL (New Zealand), NIS (Egypt), NMIA (Australia), NMIJ (Japan), NMISA (South Africa), NRC (Canada), STD-ITDI (Philippines), TISTR (Thailand), NMIM (Malaysia) and CSIRNPL (India)



4 FSFG ANNUAL MEETINGS

1st FSFG Meeting Beijing, China, 2015

- Theme: *Metrology in Food Safety*
- 20 delegates participated in the meeting

2nd FSFG Meeting Danang, Vietnam, 2016

- Theme: Measurement and Standard for Grain Food Safety and Free Trad
- 52 participants from 25 economies attended the meeting

3rd FSFG Meeting New Delhi, India, 2017

- Theme: Food Safety Activities in Member Economies
- 28 participants from 12 economies attended the meeting
- Australia, China, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailandreported on food safety activities in their economies

4th FSFG Meeting Singapore 2018

- Theme: Measurement and Capability Building in Residues of Veterinary Drugs in Meat & Seafood
- 33 participants from 16 economies attended the meeting
